RC3 Timing. No hand out transponders.

Batteries and Charging

NiMh, NiCad or Hard Cased 2S LiPo Battery. LIHV batteries will be randomly tested for overcharging.

You will need to provide your own source of power for recharging of batteries. Generators may be used but please try to ensure to position them so they are out of harm's way and so they are not an annoyance to other people attending the meeting. Please charge LiPo's in a fire sack.

Facilities

Hot Food all weekend and Toilets. Onsite Camping is available on Friday and Saturday nights.

Directions

Dirt 3D R/C Raceway, Radford Mill Farm, Radford, Bath, BA2 0QF. https://www.dirt3d.com/

Please note there are several "areas" of the farm and two principal driveway entrances: For Dirt 3D Raceway you need to use the entrance signed "Radford Mill Farm" NOT Radford Mill. Signs are put on the road on race days to assist you.

By road from Bath: Take A367 Wells Road towards Radstock, Peasedown and Shepton Mallett. Just south of Bath take a right on the A3115 towards Tunley and Timsbury. After passing through Tunley, the road goes down a hill to a miniroundabout, go straight over and continue straight on about 200 metres until the main road turns sharp right, but you go straight ahead on Weekesley Lane. Continue down Weekesley Lane about ½ mile or so and you will see a sign for Radford Mill. Continue another 500m and you will come to a sign for "Radford Mill Farm". This is the entrance into Dirt 3D Raceway. Turn in and go over the wooden bridge. Through the gate (if it is closed, please close it behind you). Continue up the track 120m and you will see a large Oak Tree. Parking and pitting is on the grass by this tree unless signs direct you otherwise.
